General information

IBM Japan Hakozaiki is located in the MSH Nihonbashi Hakozaiki Building, which is close to the Tokyo City Air Terminal(T-CAT), an airport shuttle bus stop. There is an IBM reception on the ground floor (1st floor for Japanese visitors). Please provide your name, company, and the IBM employee in charge of your visit to the receptionist.

No parking is available at the MSH Nihonbashi Hakozaiki Building. Affiliated parking lots are available near the T-CAT.

Public transportation

Subway

The closest subway station is Tokyo Metro Suitengumae Station (Z10). 250 m (3 min) walking from the Exit 2. The second closest one is Tokyo Metro Kayabacho station (H13 / T11). 650 m (7 min) walking from the Exit 4b.

Airport shuttle bus

There are ticket counters and bus stations for the limousine bus in front of the airport arrival lobbies. You will get T-CAT about 60 minutes from NRT and 30 minutes from HND.



Taxi and limo services

There are multiple taxi stands near the arrival lobby exits at the airports. With the exception of some areas, you can use taxi routes between both airports and downtown Tokyo for a fixed fare.
